




## **ATLANTIC CORRIDOR DESCRIPTION**

Implemented on the 10<sup>th</sup> of November 2013 Extended to Germany on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2016

- Around 6 200 km
- Four Members States and four IM
- Iberian (1668 mm) and UIC (1435 mm) track gauge
- Electrified and partially non electrified
- Multiple signalling system






